Black Chokeberry

Aronia Melanocarpa

- Clusters of small white flowers in May followed by purple black berries that are retained throughout the winter.
- Berries are edible and are extremely high in antioxidants
- Shiny green foliage turns wine red in fall
- Astringent taste repels deer and rabbits from nibbling on this plant
- Suckers freely for naturalistic plantings.
