## **Virginia Blue Bells**

Mertensia Virginica

- Sapphire blue flowers on tall stems that gleam from shady spots in April and May, making them an ideal underplanting for shrubs and trees.
- Upright mounds of grey-green leaves, bearing clusters of dangling pink buds that open into bright sapphire-blue bells.
- Dormant in midsummer, so use other plants to hide any gaps left behind
- Native to most of Eastern North America
