## **Kentucky Coffee Tree**

Gymnocladus dioicus

- Subtle panicles of lightly-scented white pea-like flowers hanging below the branches in late spring. Forest green foliage throughout the season. Rough, dark brown bark adds an interesting dimension to the landscape. A stately large shade tree with massive yet delicate multiply compound leaves
- Pods and seeds can be used to make a unique flavour of coffee when roasted (must be roastedseeds are toxic when raw)
- Native to Southern Ontario
