Apollo Culver's Root

Veronicastrum virginicum 'Apollo'

- Dense, slender, 9" long spikes of tiny, tube-like, lilac rose flowers open from the top down in late spring to early summer atop strong, upright stems. Bloom can extend well into the summer. Smaller, branching, erect, lateral racemes give plant a candelabra-like effect when in full bloom.
- Resembles a large veronica except the leaves are in whorls.
- A must have plant for attracting pollinators & butterflies to your garden! Deer resistant.
