Culver's Root

Veronicastrum virginicum

- Dense, slender, 9" long spikes of tiny, tube-like, white to pale blue flowers open from the top down in late spring to early summer atop strong, upright stems
- Resembles a large veronica except the leaves are in whorls.
- A must have plant for attracting pollinators & butterflies to your garden! Deer resistant.
- Solution Native to Ontario & Manitoba
