Bleeding Heart

Dicentra Spectabilis

- Forms a bushy, upright mound of light green foliage. Dangling bright pink locket flowers are held on arching stems in late spring.
- Best in partial shade, or at least protection from hot afternoon sun. After flowering, Bleeding Heart should be cut back to rejuvenate the foliage. Even still, these often go completely dormant by midsummer, to return again the following spring
