American Bladdernut

Staphylea trifolia

- White, bell-shaped flowers in drooping clusters appear in spring. Flowers give way to inflated, bladder-like, eggshaped, papery seed capsules which mature in late summer and often persist into early winter. Seed capsules add interest to dried flower arrangements
- Fast-growing, large shrub or small tree that commonly occurs in bottomlands, woodland thickets and moist soils along streams
- Native to Ontario
