*Pycnanthemum pilosum*

- ❁ Features white flowers on top of hairy gray foliage. Honeybees love this minty perennial so much that they sometimes sleep on the blossoms at night. A pollinator magnet.
- ❁ Leaves have a pleasing minty fragrance when crushed, they are often used to flavour teas.
- ❁ Great for naturalizing in native gardens, rock gardens, dry meadows or herb gardens
- ❁ Also called American mountain mint
