Baptisia alba

- Excellent choice for sunny gardens. Plants form a tall, bushy clump of greygreen foliage, with long spikes of pea-like flowers, in shades of creamy white.
- A good substitute for Lupines, in areas where they are difficult to grow.
- Makes an excellent cut flower, also attractive to butterflies. Unattractive to slugs, deer and rabbits. Drought tolerant, once established.
- Native to North America


