American Larch


Larix Iaracina

- Open and pyramidal with horizontal drooping branches. Needles turn yellow in the fall and drop off for the winter
- Best grown in moist, acidic, welldrained soils in full sun. Tolerates some light shade
- Also known as Tamarack, Hackmatack, Eastern Larch, & Alaska larch, juniper
- Native to all of Canada
