

# American Larch

*Larix laricina*

- ❁ Open and pyramidal with horizontal drooping branches. Needles turn yellow in the fall and drop off for the winter
- ❁ Best grown in moist, acidic, well-drained soils in full sun. Tolerates some light shade
- ❁ Also known as Tamarack, Hackmatack, Eastern Larch, & Alaska larch, juniper
- ❁ Native to all of Canada
