Clematis x 'Venosa Violacea'

- 4-5" blooms feature icy white central bands with increasing royal purple veining towards nearly solid purple edges, gives a star effect
- Blooms on new growth. A hard pruning in late winter\early spring will help produce a well balanced plant. Cut back to 2 sets of strong buds on each stem
- Clematis are among the most showy of all the vines. The roots like to be kept cool so cover them with mulch or a ground cover
