Red Arrow Culver's Root

Veronicastrum virginicum 'Red Arrow'

- Bears dense spikes of red buds which open from the top down into deep violet flowers from July to September on strong, upright stems. Smaller, branching lateral spikes create a candelabra-like effect when in full bloom. Resembles a large veronica except the leaves are in whorls.
- A must have plant for attracting pollinators & butterflies to your garden! Deer resistant.
- Native to Ontario & Manitoba
