

Clematis 'Multi-Blue'

- ❁ Large double blue flowers have navy blue outer flower petals, topped with many layers of shorter, pointed, purplish reddish petals
- ❁ Flowers in May - June on old wood and it blooms again in September on the current seasons growth. The second set of blooms are either semi-double or single
- ❁ A light pruning in late winter\early spring will help produce a well balanced plant. Any weak or dead wood should be removed at this time.
